# Proposed Resolution to be adopted at the 11th General Assembly of the Roundtable on Sustainable Palm Oil (RSPO)

### 20<sup>th</sup> November 2014

### TITLE: DECLARATION OF MILLS

#### Submitted by: Unilever

#### Background Information:

With the recent increase in the commitments by certain RSPO members toward oil palm traceability in the supply chain, the transparency of the mill origin is becoming a very important issue.

Currently, there are no industry wide system available to deliver traceability to mill or plantations. Companies have to work with their palm oil suppliers to implement traceability systems.

Unilever recognizes the value of traceability throughout the supply chain to deliver the overall objective of RSPO member companies to achieve zero deforestation in the value chain. As a first step, it would be useful to declare the known certified mills that are linked to book & claim, mass balance or segregated systems.

#### **Resolution:**

- 1. to require origin of the certified Crude Palm Oil or Palm Kernel Oil mills to be declared on the GreenPalm certificate for Book & Claim system.
- 2. to require known origin of certified Crude Palm Oil or Palm Kernel Oil mills to be declared in the RSPO E trace system for mass balance and segregated.
